Making Up is the fifth single from Gilad's third studio album, *As Time Goes By*. Written and composed by Gilad, the song explores what happens after a major argument—when love becomes more important than winning. It's a reminder that life is too short to waste on unnecessary fights, and that choosing to make up is often the greatest victory of all. Hidden within the lyrics is a subtle tribute to The Beatles.

The track was produced by Gilad and Valerie Lipets. It features the late Asher Fedi on drums, Valery Lipets on bass and keyboards, Corky James on guitars, and Gilad on lead and backing vocals.

Gilad is a singer-songwriter and composer whose first two albums featured original musical settings of works by some of the greatest poets in the English language, including Edgar Allan Poe, Rudyard Kipling, Alfred Tennyson, and others. His music has received airplay on radio stations across Europe and the Americas, while his song "Annabel Lee" reached the finals of the prestigious Song of the Year international songwriting competition and was also performed by the acclaimed CONCORO Choir under the direction of Artistic Director Emeritus Richard Coffey.

With *As Time Goes By*, Gilad opens a new chapter in his career. For the first time, every song on the album is deeply personal, inspired by his family, relationships, and the everyday moments that shape our lives. Each track tells a true story, turning ordinary experiences into heartfelt songs that listeners can easily recognize as their own.

Making Up is a celebration of Romance, forgiveness, love, and the simple realization that some things are far more important than being right.
